Organizing an Expository Essay

A well-organized essay is easy to follow and persuasive.

Consider using an outline to structure your thoughts and ensure a logical flow of ideas.

Introduction	Hook, background information, thesis statement
Body Paragraphs	Develop each supporting point with evidence and analysis.
Conclusion	Restate thesis, summarize main points, offer a final thought.

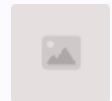

Revising and Editing for Clarity

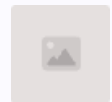
Revising and editing are crucial steps in the writing process.

Take time to review your work for clarity, coherence, and grammatical errors.



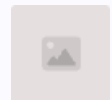
Clarity
